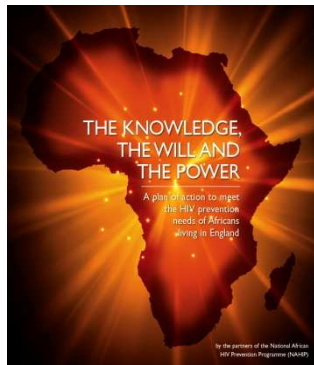

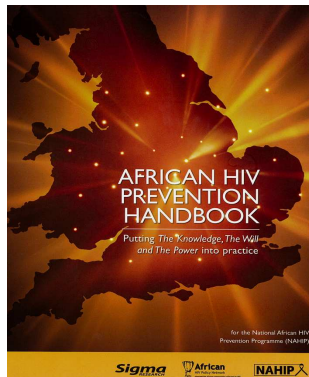




About the Training:
